Under this agreement for 2017 Carole Park State School will receive

\$157,805*


This funding will be used to

- Increase the number of Prep-2 students reading above Level 5 to 80% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving at National Minimum Standard in Reading in Year 3 60% (2017) to 80% (2018).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving at National Minimum Standard in Reading in year 5 60% (2017) to 80% in (2018).
- Improve student engagement throughout the school led by the school leadership team, through building teacher capability in the areas of pedagogical practices and providing a supportive and differentiated learning environment.


Our initiatives include

- Continuing to build teacher and teacher aide capacity in the teaching of reading.
- Continuing the 'Mini Lit' literacy intervention in year 1.
- Providing classrooms with additional teacher aide time to improve the student to teacher ratio during the literacy block.
- Building teacher capacity in data literacy to enable them to cater for students' needs in reading. This will be supported by the Master Teachers action research in the area of goal setting and case management.
- Professionally developing teachers on research based pedagogical practices (Archer & Hughes – Explicit Instruction) supported by a coaching and feedback model.
- Employing a student services teacher and a special education teacher to implement differentiated planning and teaching to improve student engagement at all curriculum levels throughout the school.
- Implement research based behaviour system (Positive Behaviour for Learning) to systematically improve student engagement in the classroom.
