Carole Park State School will receive**

\$172,205*

This funding will be used to:

- increase the percentage of students achieving at National Minimum Standard in Reading in Year 3 to 80%
- increase the percentage of students achieving Regional Reading Benchmarks (PM7) in Prep to 80%
- improve student engagement throughout the school, led by the school leadership team, through building teacher capability in the areas of pedagogical practices and providing a supportive and differentiated learning environment.

Our initiatives include:

- implementing a data driven intervention program based on Early Start data collection in Years Prep to Year 2, with the program being led by the Head of Curriculum and supported by employing a specialised literacy teacher aide
- continuing to employ a Student Services – Head of Curriculum to support teachers with the implementation of:
 - research-based pedagogical practices (Archer & Hughes – Explicit Instruction)
 - teacher coaching and feedback model
 - research-based behaviour management systems (Positive Behaviour for Learning) in all classes to further improve student engagement at all curriculum levels throughout the school.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employ teacher aide to implement P-2 literacy intervention program.	\$ 42,205
Continue employing a Student Service – Head of Curriculum to implement researched based pedagogical and classroom management systems to improve teacher capabilities and student engagement.	\$130,000
