

# Investing for Success

**Under this agreement for 2022  
Carole Park State School will receive**

**\$143,620\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of prep students achieving Cluster 3 or above in Writing (Literacy continuum P-2) to 50%.
- Increase the percentage year 1 students achieving Cluster 5 or above in Writing (Literacy continuum P-2) to 50%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C standard or above for English by 15%.
- Employ an additional teacher to build a culture of professional learning through teacher release, collaboration and facilitation of coaching and mentoring.
- Employ additional 0.4 teacher to support Early Years intervention and to release staff for scheduled student support meetings.
- Enhance learning spaces with flexible furniture to provide spaces to engage students in group work.

## Our initiatives include

- Teachers will engage in planning meetings and scheduled staff meetings to develop and revise English Units that engage students in meaningful and appropriately challenging learning (Curriculum, Reporting and Assessment Framework requirements).
- Teachers will be provided with scheduled opportunities to engage in professional learning and visits to observe classrooms within and beyond the school to improve Literacy pedagogy.
- Teacher Aides will engage in fortnightly professional learning to improve pedagogy, targeting Reading and Writing in small groups. Teacher planning will include explicit group work expectations for Teacher Aides during Literacy Blocks. (John Hattie, *Teacher Clarity* 0.75 Effect Size).
- Establish daily Perceptual Motor Program access for Prep and Year 1 students (School based AEDC data).
- Create inviting learning spaces in years 4-6 where students access fit for purpose learning spaces to work in small groups.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing additional teachers - 1.4 full-time equivalent (FTE) to develop a collaborative culture of professional learning.	\$120 000
Engaging Teacher Aides in professional learning to support Literacy Blocks.	\$10 000
Investing in independent, flexible classroom furniture to establish student agency in years 4-6.	\$13 620
