**Under this agreement for 2021
Carole Park State School will receive**

\$150,420*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading in Years 3 and 5 to 90%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Reading in year 3 to 20%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Reading in year 5 to 20%.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a grade of 'C' or higher in English to 80% at their curriculum level.
- Employ an additional Head of Department – Curriculum to imbed Rigorous Reading pedagogy in Years 3 to 6 and professional develop teachers in Years Prep to 2 on applying text dependent questioning techniques across the curriculum.
- Continue to employ additional Teacher Aide time to support inclusive practices in the classroom for students who require additional support with classroom engagement.
- Continue to employ an additional teacher resulting in a reduction of class numbers across all year levels.

Our initiatives include

- Teachers in Years 3 to 6 will receive scheduled professional development, coaching and feedback on their implementation of Rigorous Reading (Fisher and Frey).
- Teachers in Years Prep to 2 will receive scheduled professional development, coaching and feedback on their implementation of text dependent questioning techniques (Fisher and Frey).
- Creation of an additional class resulting in improved teacher to student ratio.
- Teacher aide time will continue to support differentiation within the classroom resulting in inclusive education for all students at Carole Park SS.

Employing a Head of Department – Curriculum to develop teacher capability.	\$ 55 000
Employing an additional classroom teacher.	\$ 83 000
Continuing to employ additional Teacher Aide time to support inclusive education across the school.	\$ 12 420
