Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- ➔ Collaboratively develop precise targets and timelines aligned to student outcomes for the effective implementation of the explicit improvement agenda.
- ➔ Strengthen teacher knowledge and capability to apply differentiation processes in day-to-day teaching, including a focus on students who have the potential to be high achieving.
- ➔ Embed moderation practices to include authentic 'before, after, after, end' processes within and beyond the school.
- ➔ Collaboratively track vertical alignment of the Australian Curriculum to ensure full coverage of the achievement standards to accommodate varying school class structures.
- ➔ Develop a formal school mentoring, modelling and coaching process that is negotiated with staff members and differentiated to meet the needs of all participants.
